General Education - Preparation of National Population Register - Service of Teachers as enumerators - conditions - Order issued.

ORDER

The survey for the preparation of National Population Register (NPR) is being conducted in the Coastal Panchayat of Kerala. The work involves enumeration of about 120 households by a teacher in clearly demarcated areas. As per DO letter read as 1st paper above it is requested to give sufficient instructions to the authorities concerned to see that service of Primary teachers are obtained as per requirements for successful completion of enumeration work for the preparation of National Population Register in our State. The Secretary General Education Department had a discussion with the representatives of the Teachers Organisation.

In the above circumstances, Government are pleased to order that the service of the school teachers will be used for the preparation of National Population Register (NPR) in Kerala with the following conditions

- 1. The teachers shouldn't be sent for training or survey during the mid year examination period (October 21st to 30th 2009)
- 2. Teachers teaching upto 7th Standard (LP and UP Section) and willing High School assistants could be used for enumeration purpose.
- 3. Teachers of central schools may also be used wherever possible and the staff of Fisheries department and Revenue department may also be deployed.
- 4. Those who are willing may be deputed first. If not sufficient, other teachers also may be deputed. But medically unfit teachers will be excluded.
- 5. As far as possible, more than 20% of teachers from a school will not be deployed at a time. Training and enumeration could be done in staggered

batches. Teachers handling classes having only one division in a swill be excluded from enumeration as even combining of two wouldn't be possible in such cases and the pupils will have to lunattended.

- 6. The teachers will be deployed to do the work on non-teaching days.
- 7. As far as possible, teachers will be deputed to the same area in which work. In the event of non availability of teachers from the same others will also be deputed.
- 8. The number of households should not be more than the pres number as usually happens.
- Representatives of teachers organisation will be involved by the I Collectors in grievance redressal.
- 10. Wherever the survey is going on smoothly, no change need be enow. The teachers already trained will undertake the work immediathout affecting their normal work.
